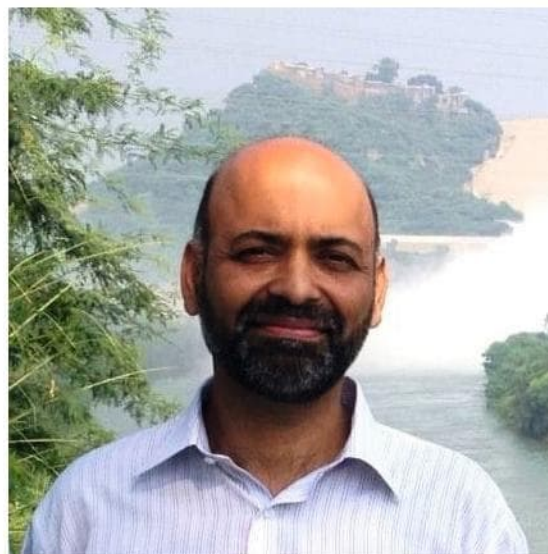

The worldwide week of Sight First program (4-10 October 2015) was held at Ch. Muhammad Hussain Natt Trust Eye Hospital G-8, Markaz, Islamabad Pakistan

The treatment of 700 patients were executed in the week, out of which 86 patients were referred for the cataract surgery. However, due to some medical complications diagnosed in some of the patients, were referred to different fame institutes of Islamabad and Rawalpindi and 36 cataract operations were successfully performed during the worldwide week of Sight First.

District Bagh Azad Jamu & Kashmir

The Four Days (31 Dec, 1 Jan, 2 Jan, 3 Jan.) Eye Camp was held at the Dheer Kot High School District Bagh, Azad Kashmir. The Ummah Welfare Trust and CMHN Trust supported in all the technical aspects, the doctors as well as paramedics in the camp. Besides, the patients were offered free cataract surgery. Local Volunteer Persons undertook publicity and management of the camp. They also contributed towards transportation of the patients. Our targeted of 2500 patients, The treatment of 1800 patients were executed in the camp, out of which 96 patients were referred for the cataract surgery. However, due to some medical complications diagnosed in some of the patients, were referred to Shifa Eye Trust Hospital Rawalpindi and 56 operations were successfully carried out in the Camp on 3 Jan 2016

Presentation: Complaint of headache on and off from 15 days. And visited at Khanna branch of Ch. Muhammad Hussain Natt Trust Eye Hospital for routine eye examination.

Examination & Diagnosis: On examination we find that his Visual Acuity in both eyes was Counting finger, which has improved with pinhole i.e. 6/24p in both eyes and we have also observed horizontal latent nystagmus which becomes manifest on occluding right eye.

Advice: We advised him best optical correction and his visual acuity with best optical correction was 6/18 with -7.50DS in BE.

Follow Up: After One Month

Presented with complain of grittiness in left eye after left cataract surgery from Al Shifa Trust Eye Hospital Rawalpindi 3 years ago.

She visited many Senior Ophthalmic Consultants in Rawalpindi, Islamabad Region and also visited Al Shifa Trust Eye Hospital.

She heard of CMHN Hospital from one of her relative. On visit to CMHN hospital complete eye examination was done by optometrist Kaukab Khan who found loose eye stitches in her left eye on slit lamp examination. Eyelids, cornea and AC were quiet. Patient was referred to Consultant Ophthalmologist Prof. Dr. Abdul Munim for removal of stitches (ROS).

Dr. Munim removed patient's stitches in minor OT and prescribed antibiotic steroid eye drops for two weeks.

Follow-up:

After two weeks and seems very satisfied. She was very grateful to CMHN hospital. It was a simple case but was being overlooked by many senior ophthalmologists. According to my understanding all it depends is on keen observation, giving importance to patient's problem and a thorough examination.
